Lead and Copper Rule Info as of March 28, 2018

Bayou Liberty Water Association is a privately-owned, non-profit potable water system located in Wards 8 & 9 of St. Tammany Parish that was established on June 23, 1969. We serve water to a population of approximately 10,500. Our water system is comprised of 3 active water wells, 2 reserve wells, 4 hydropneumatic tanks, one ground storage tank and a 100,000 gallon elevated water tower. The material inventory of our distribution system is piping made up of approximately 97% PVC and 3% iron or steel. Our service lines from the water main to the meters are PVC or Polyethelene pipe.

Since the inception of the Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals Lead and Copper Rule, Bayou Liberty Water Association has performed all required sampling and has never exceeded the 90th percentile of the current action levels.
